

INFORMATION ON PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

pursuant to the provisions of Regulation (EU) No 182/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of security data, repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (hereinafter "Regulation") and, where applicable, the relevant provisions of the Act No. 18/2018 Coll., of 29 November 2017, on the protection of personal data, as amended (hereinafter the "Act")

This "Notice" explains the scope and manner of collection and processing of your personal data by the city Nitra, with its seat at Štefánikova trieda 60, 950 06 Nitra, ID: 00 308 307., (hereinafter only „Controller“), acting as controller, in the scope of processing activities connected with receiving of ideas from the public in connection with candidacy of Nitra for the title of European Capital of Culture 2026

The scope of personal data processed

- title, name and surname, e-mail address, organization affiliation, name of the project
- other personal data stated in the project description or in the attached document

The purpose of the processing

- enabling participation of the public in the creation of ideas in connection with Nitra's candidacy for the title of European Capital of Culture 2026

The legal basis for the processing

- the legal basis for the processing is pursuing of the legitimate interest of the Controller (Article 6, para. 1 f) of the Regulation), particularly interests in:
 - effective public participation in the development of ideas for the title of European Capital of Culture 2026,
 - full and complete consideration of the submitted idea,
 - identification of the author of the idea and ensuring the possibility of feedback.

Other relevant information connected with this processing activity

- personal data are stored only for a period that is necessary for fulfillment of the designated purpose of processing, with the maximum retention period being the year 2026 (the year of Nitra's candidature for the title of European Capital of Culture)
- personal data are collected directly from the data subject
- personal data are processed only by the Controller
- personal data may, in exceptional circumstances, be provided to law enforcement authorities, relevant authorities in the field of administrative offences
- the Controller does not intend to transfer personal data to a third country or to an international organization
- personal data are not subject to profiling or automated decision making
- provision of personal data is voluntary; the data subject can freely decide whether to provide such data

Your rights connected with this processing activity

As a data subject you have the following rights in relation to the processing of personal data related to you:

- right to request information about whether we process such personal data
- right to request a copy of such personal data
- right to rectification of personal data
- right to erasure of personal data ("right to be forgotten")
- right to restriction of processing of personal data

- right to object to the processing of personal data

Instruction on exercising rights of the data subjects towards us

As a data subject you can exercise your rights towards us at any time through the following means:

- in person, at our address stated in the beginning of this Notice

Right to file a complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office of the Slovak Republic

In addition to the above-mentioned rights, you, as the data subject, have the right to file a direct complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office of the Slovak Republic (*Úrad ochrany osobných údajov SR*).
